You may access this information by using the following directions:

- Log in to IC
- In the search box, type in the name of your student
- Once the student has been selected, click on the “Index” tab
- Student Information, PLP, General
- On the right side of the screen, below the students name, you will see a technology tab
- The three red arrows below show you where you can find the information. If the AUP box is not checked, the student does not have an AUP on file and therefore should not be using any type of technology. If the No Picture box is checked, the student should not have their picture published or used in print or on any social media. If the BYOT box is checked, the student has completed all necessary paperwork to bring their own technology and has access to the wireless network .
